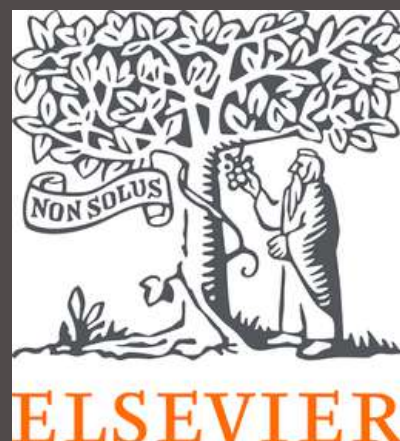

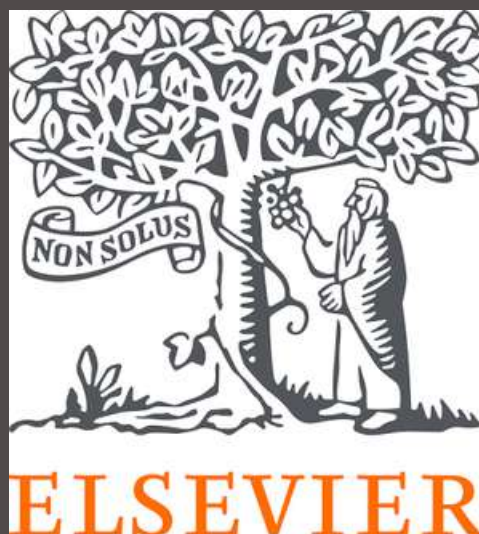

D. Pharmacy Students Gain Practical Exposure Through Educational Visit to Sunny Pharma, Satara



Satara, July 11, 2026: YSPM's Yashoda Technical Campus, Faculty of D. Pharmacy, organized an educational field visit to Sunny Pharma, Satara, for Second Year Diploma in Pharmacy students on 11th July 2026. A total of 43 students, accompanied by two faculty members, participated in the visit.

The visit commenced at 3.00 p.m. with a warm welcome by Mr. Bhadresh Shah, Proprietor of Sunny Pharma. He delivered an informative presentation on the functioning of a pharmaceutical distribution agency, covering procurement, storage, inventory management, billing, order processing, and distribution of medicines to retail pharmacies and healthcare institutions. Mr. Shah highlighted the importance of maintaining proper documentation, including purchase records, credit notes, invoices, and stock registers, while emphasizing compliance with Good Distribution Practices (GDP).

The students then undertook a guided tour of the distribution facility, where they observed the systematic arrangement of medicines, storage conditions, and computerized inventory management systems. Special attention was given to temperature-sensitive products, stock rotation using the FEFO (First Expiry First Out) principle, and billing software for efficient inventory control.

An interactive question-and-answer session followed, allowing students to clarify their queries regarding order management, record maintenance, billing software, inventory control, and the role of pharmaceutical distributors in ensuring the uninterrupted supply of quality medicines. The visit proved highly informative and helped students connect theoretical concepts with real-world pharmaceutical distribution practices. They gained a better understanding of the pharmaceutical supply chain from manufacturer to retailer and the role of distributors in ensuring the continuous availability of medicines.

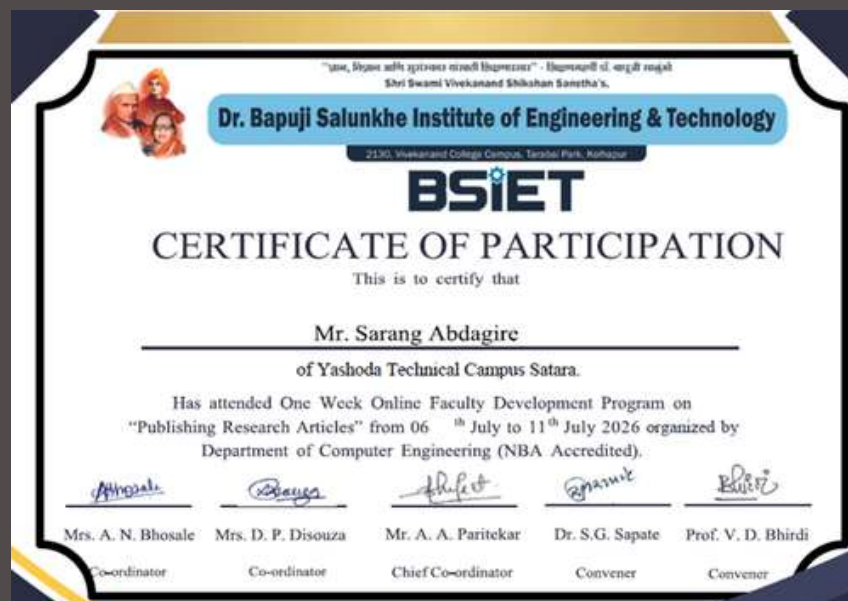
