YTC Faculty of Pharmacy Showcases Research Excellence with Q1 Scopus-Indexed

The Faculty of Pharmacy, Yashoda Technical Campus, Satara, proudly congratulates Mrs. Pallavi S. Gaikwad (Salve) on the successful publication of her research article in the internationally acclaimed European Journal of Pharmaceutics and Biopharmaceutics, a prestigious Scopus Indexed Q1 journal published by Elsevier. The journal has an Impact Factor of 5.0 and a CiteScore of 7.9, reflecting its high academic reputation, rigorous peer-review standards, and global recognition in the field of pharmaceutical sciences. This significant achievement highlights the institution's growing research excellence and commitment to promoting high-quality scientific publications at the international level.

Her research article, titled "Green Synthesized β -Caryophyllene Oxide Enriched Fraction-Derived Carbon Quantum Dots Trigger ROS Production and p53 Activation in HepG2 Cells," presents an innovative and environmentally sustainable approach in the fields of nanomedicine and cancer research. The study focuses on the green synthesis of carbon quantum dots derived from β -caryophyllene oxide-enriched fractions and investigates their ability to induce reactive oxygen species (ROS) production and activate the tumor suppressor protein p53 in HepG2 liver cancer cells. The research demonstrates the promising potential of eco-friendly nanomaterials for targeted cancer therapy and contributes significantly to the advancement of sustainable pharmaceutical nanotechnology. The findings are expected to encourage further research on green nanomaterials for biomedical applications and the development of safer and more effective therapeutic strategies.

This remarkable accomplishment is a testament to Mrs. Gaikwad's dedication, perseverance, scientific curiosity, and commitment to research excellence. Her publication in a globally reputed Q1 journal not only enhances her academic credentials but also strengthens the research profile and scholarly reputation of Yashoda Technical Campus.
