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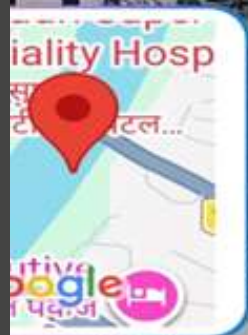
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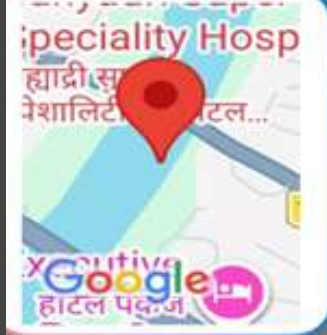

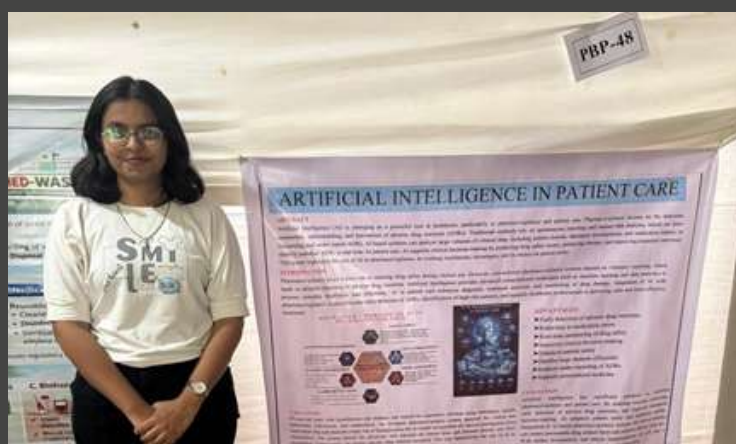
YSPM's Yashoda Technical Campus, Faculty of Pharmacy, organized an educational hospital visit for First Year B. Pharm students at Sahyadri Super Speciality Hospital, Karad on 14th February 2026. The visit was conducted under the guidance of Principal Dr. Prakash D. Jadhav and coordinated by Ms. A. V. Adsul along with Mrs. S. S. Gole, with the objective of providing practical exposure to hospital pharmacy operations and healthcare management systems. 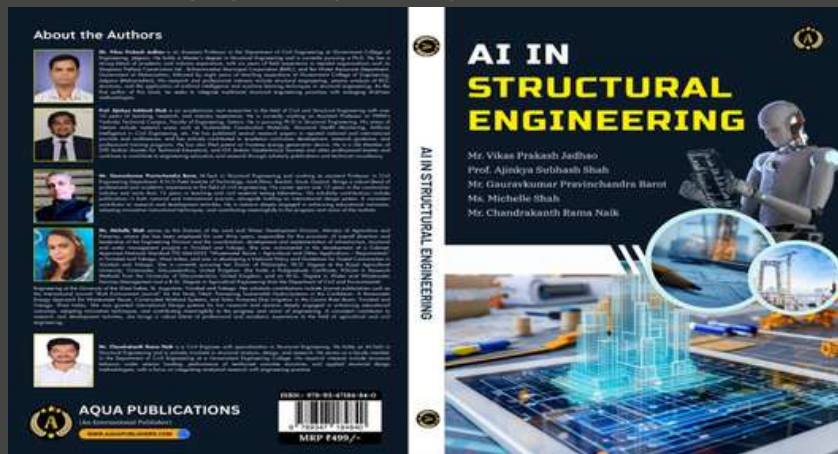

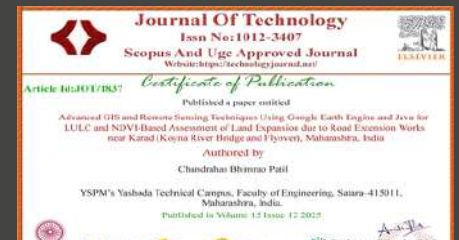

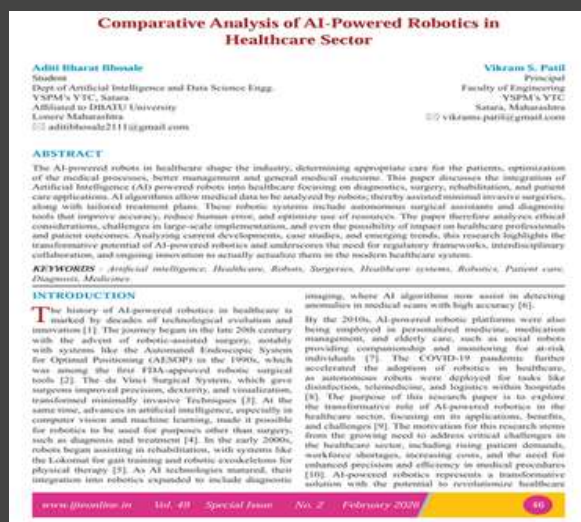
