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

GUEST LECTURE ON "OVERTHINKING" CONDUCTED AT YSPM'S YTC, DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY

YSPMS Yashoda Technical Campus, Faculty of Pharmacy, successfully organized a Guest Lecture on "Overthinking" under the domain of Human Values on 21st January 2026, from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm. The session was conducted for First Year B. Pharmacy and Pharm D students with the aim of promoting mental well-being, emotional balance, and lifelong learning. The lecture was delivered by Mrs. Uma A. Bhosale, a renowned Clinical Psychologist, who shared her professional expertise and practical experiences related to mental health. The session focused on creating awareness about overthinking, its psychological impact, and effective strategies to manage it in academic and personal life. Mrs. Bhosale began by explaining the concept of overthinking and distinguishing it from healthy thinking. She highlighted how excessive negative thoughts, commonly arising from academic pressure, career uncertainty, fear of failure, and personal expectations, can lead to stress, anxiety, reduced concentration, and poor decision-making. The causes of overthinking such as perfectionism, self-doubt, and social comparison were discussed using relatable real-life examples. The resource person introduced practical techniques including mindfulness, positive self-talk, time management, and cognitive restructuring to help students overcome overthinking patterns. The session strongly emphasized human values such as self-awareness, emotional intelligence, empathy, mental resilience, and acceptance of imperfections. Students were encouraged to focus on solutions rather than problems, thereby strengthening their planning abilities, problem-analysis skills, communication, and lifelong learning attitude. The lecture was highly interactive, with students actively participating by sharing their concerns and asking questions. Mrs. Bhosale patiently addressed the queries and offered constructive guidance, making the session engaging and impactful.
