## TRAINING SESSIONS IN PHARMACOVIGILANCE AND MEDICAL CODING FOR FINAL YEAR B. PHARM STUDENTS

DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY



From 9th to 12th March 2026, the Faculty Training & Development Cell of Yashoda Technical Campus, Faculty of Pharmacy, Satara, successfully organized a comprehensive four-day student training program titled "Foundations of Pharmacovigilance and Regulatory Compliance." Designed specifically for 76 Final Year B. Pharm students, the intensive workshop aimed to bridge the divide between academic theory and the rigorous expectations of the global healthcare IT and pharmaceutical sectors. Under the coordination of Mrs. S.S. Gole, the program provided a roadmap for students to transition into professional roles with technical competence and industry-readiness. The first three days focused on the core pillars of Pharmacovigilance, led by industry veterans Mr. Vishal C. Sonawane, Mr. Yogesh Patil, and Mr. Sagar R. Sonawane. These experts shared their vast experience in Individual Case Safety Report (ICSR) processing, MedDRA coding, and narrative writing. Students gained hands-on insights into adverse event assessment and regulatory compliance, learning how to navigate complex pharmacovigilance databases. The sessions also touched upon the transformative role of Artificial Intelligence in modern drug safety monitoring, keeping the participants engaged with the latest technological trends in healthcare research. The final day shifted focus to the specialized field of Medical Coding, featuring sessions by Ms. Aashwini Bhagwat and Ms. Asmita Phalke, both certified professionals with extensive experience in US healthcare documentation. They introduced students to essential coding systems including ICD-10, CPT, and HCPCS, while emphasizing the importance of human anatomy and medical terminology in insurance billing processes. Beyond technical training, the experts provided invaluable career guidance on resume building and interview strategies for the Healthcare IT sector.

The program concluded with a valedictory session graced by Principal Dr. P.D. Jadhav, HOD Dr. A.M. Bhagwat, and Mr. Mahesh Marathe. #### FIELD VISIT AT PHC, PADALI

DEPARTMENT OF D PHARMACY



A Primary Health Centre (PHC) is the first point of contact for individuals seeking healthcare services, providing essential preventive, diagnostic, and therapeutic care to improve community health and wellbeing. YSPM's YTC, Department of Diploma in Pharmacy organized a field visit to the Primary Health Centre at Padali, Satara on 18th March 2026 for First Year D. Pharm students as part of the Social Pharmacy curriculum. A total of 40 students participated under the guidance of faculty members Mrs. P. A. Kadam and Mrs. A. A. Nikam. The visit began with a welcome address by Medical Officer Dr. Nayana Ghorpade, who provided an overview of services such as OPD, IPD, vaccination, infrastructure, and staffing, and highlighted that the PHC serves a population of approximately 5000 people.

During the visit, students explored various sections including the vaccination room, TB unit, general ward, neonatal care unit, and pharmacy section, gaining practical exposure to primary healthcare services and the role of pharmacists in community health. They were also introduced to different records and registers maintained for effective healthcare management. Additionally, the Medical Officer explained important government health schemes such as Chiranjeevi Yojana, Janani Suraksha Yojana, and PM-JAY, aimed at improving healthcare accessibility and maternal and child health outcomes. The field visit was successfully conducted under the guidance of President Prof. Dr. Dasharath Sagare, Vice-President Prof. Dr. Ajinkya Sagare, Principal Dr. P. D. Jadhav, and HOD Prof. A. T. #### FIELD VISIT AT WATER TREATMENT PLANT

DEPARTMENT OF D PHARMACY



YSPM's YTC, Department of Diploma in Pharmacy organized a field visit to the Water Treatment Plant at the Deputy Engineer Office, MIDC, Satara on 18th March 2026 for First Year D. Pharm students. Around 40 students participated under the guidance of Mrs. P. A. Kadam and Mrs. A. A. Nikam. The main objectives of the visit were to understand the importance of safe and clean water supply, study the various stages involved in water

treatment processes, and create awareness about water conservation and environmental protection. The visit began at 11:00 am and was guided by Mr. Vinayak Kadam and Mrs. Shilpa Sakunde, who provided detailed insights into the functioning of the plant.

During the visit, students observed different stages of water treatment, starting from the collection of raw water from the Krishna River. The treatment process included the addition of alum and bentonite (during the rainy season), followed by flocculation in a clariflocculator where sludge was formed and removed. Further purification was carried out through sedimentation and sand filtration, and finally chlorination was done for disinfection before storing the treated water in a reservoir for distribution. The visit provided valuable practical knowledge about large-scale water purification and highlighted the importance of clean water for human health and community wellbeing. It concluded at 12:30 pm with a group photograph and was successfully conducted under the guidance of President Prof. Dr. Dasharath Sagare, Vice-President Prof. Dr. Ajinkya Sagare, Principal Dr. P. D. Jadhav, and HOD Prof. A. T. Thorat.

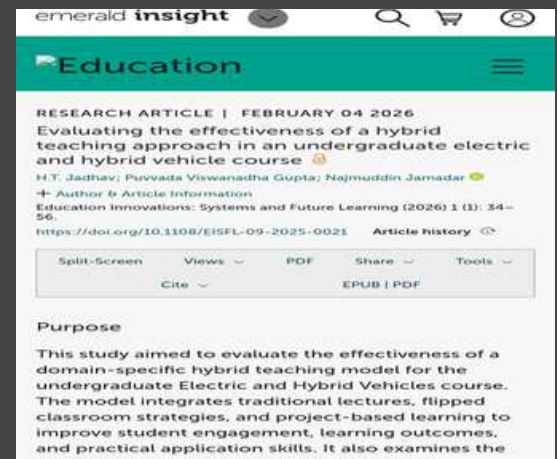

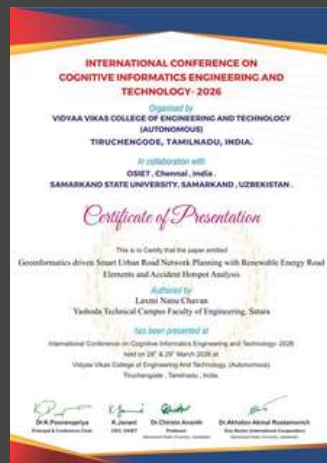

### CERTIFICATE COURSE ON ARCHITECTURAL DOCUMENTATION OF HATTI GHAT & KOTESHWAR TEMPLE
