GUEST LECTURE

DEPARTMENT OF MBA



Topic: Labor Law

The Department of Management (MBA), Yashoda Technical Campus, Satara, organised an insightful guest lecture on “Managing Conflict and Compliance: The Role of Industrial Laws in Modern Workplaces” on 10th November 2025 in the Seminar Hall. The session was delivered by Adv. Mr. Mukund Phadake, a seasoned legal professional with over 25 years of practice at Satara District Court, who brought rich industry experience and academic clarity to the discussion.

The objective of the session was to help students understand the legal framework governing industrial relations and provide them with practical knowledge on managing workplace conflicts. The lecture closely aligned with the Industrial Relations curriculum and focused on the Industrial Employment (Standing Orders) Act, 1946 and the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947. Mr. Phadake explained how these laws aim to standardise employment conditions, promote industrial peace, and address disputes effectively. He elaborated on provisions related to employee conduct, shift work, retirement norms, strikes, lockouts, lay-offs, and retrenchment, with emphasis on procedural safeguards and the importance of compliance.

The speaker highlighted the role of works committees, conciliation officers, and labour courts, illustrating how different stakeholders collaborate to resolve conflicts and maintain industrial harmony. Students appreciated the clarity with which legal terminologies and processes were explained, especially through real-life examples drawn from landmark judgments and practical experience.

An interactive Q&A session allowed students to clarify doubts regarding legal implications in real-world scenarios, compliance challenges, and trends in industrial dispute resolution.

EDUCATIONAL VISIT TO ONCO-LIFE CANCER CENTER, SATARA

DEPARTMENT OF PHARMACY



The F.Y. Pharm D students of Yashoda Technical Campus, Faculty of Pharmacy, Satara visited Onco-Life Cancer Center, Shendre, Satara on 29th November 2025 to gain real-time exposure to oncology-based healthcare practices. The visit aimed to enhance students' understanding of cancer diagnosis, treatment, hospital pharmacy operations, and the multidisciplinary approach involved in modern cancer care.

Students were welcomed with an orientation session conducted by Mr. Raj Ghadge, who briefed them about the center's mission, specialized facilities, and comprehensive patient-care model. The visit included a guided tour through advanced diagnostic departments such as Radiology and Pathology, where students observed CT, MRI, PET scans, biopsy procedures, histopathology, and tumor marker analysis. This exposure helped students understand the clinical significance of diagnostic tools in cancer detection and monitoring.

A major highlight was the demonstration at the Chemotherapy Day Care Unit, where students learned about chemotherapy preparation, cytotoxic drug handling, infusion techniques, patient monitoring, and essential safety protocols. At the Oncology Pharmacy, students were introduced to anticancer drug storage systems, dose calculations, sterile compounding, and biosafety measures. The session emphasized the vital role of pharmacists in medication safety, error prevention, and patient counselling.

Interactive discussions with oncologists, pharmacists, and nursing staff further deepened students' knowledge of cancer prevention, treatment protocols, palliative care, and emerging trends such as personalized medicine. The visit successfully helped students connect classroom learning with clinical practice, building their confidence and professional outlook.

The department aims to continue conducting such awareness programs to help students develop essential life skills beyond academics.



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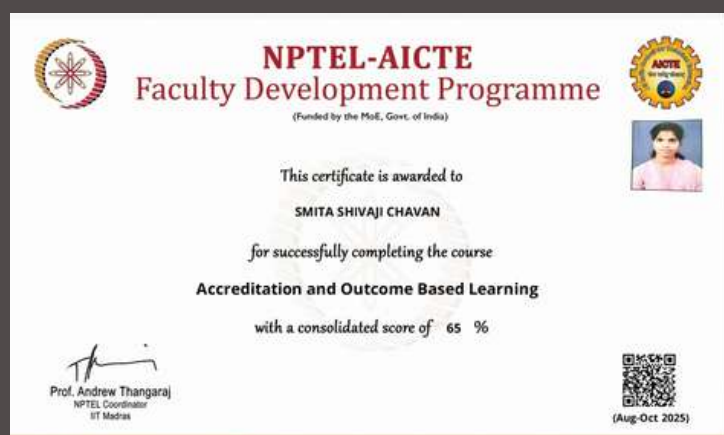

Multi-objective CEED optimization in large-scale generator systems via GMOABC and NSGA-II integration

ABSTRACT
This paper proposes a hybrid metaheuristic algorithm, GMOABC-NSGA-II, to solve the Combined Economic Emission Dispatch (CEED) problem in large-scale power systems. The study aims to minimize total fuel cost and gaseous emissions while satisfying generator operating limits and power balance constraints. The proposed method integrates the global exploration ability of the Global Best Guided Artificial Bee Colony (GMOABC) with the non-dominated sorting and diversity preservation features of NSGA-II, ensuring both convergence accuracy and Pareto front diversity. The algorithm's performance is evaluated on four benchmark systems consisting of 40, 80, 120, and 140 thermal generating units with total load demands ranging from 10,500 MW to 35,000 MW. For the 40-unit system, the best compromise solution achieved a fuel cost of 1.0053×10^6 \$/h and emission of 3.1281×10^4 kg/h, with zero constraint violation. The standard deviation across 10 runs remained within 1.1%, confirming high consistency. The algorithm also achieved up to 3.8% lower fuel cost and 4.5% lower emission compared to conventional techniques. Statistical metrics such as Spacing Index (0.0084) and Hypervolume (0.9427) validate the generation of a well-distributed Pareto front. These results demonstrate the suitability of the GMOABC-NSGA-II algorithm for real-time economic and environmental scheduling in modern large-scale power systems.

HERITAGE EXPLORATION TREK TO PATESHWAR TEMPLE, SATARA – WORLD HERITAGE WEEK 2025–26 (DAY 02)

On 20th November 2025, as part of World Heritage Week 2025–26, students of YSPM's Yashoda College of Architecture participated in an enriching Pateshwar Heritage Trek (Day 02) at the foothills of Pateshwar Temple, Satara. The event was coordinated by Ar. Vipul Salavankar, Ar. Shaunak Kadam, and Ar. Dhanashree Babar under the academic schedule for the year 2025–26.

The trek was guided by Ar. Sourabh Marathe (Asst. Prof., BNCA and Executive Committee Member, INTACH – Pune Chapter), who provided an insightful historical briefing on the architectural, cultural, and spiritual significance of the Pateshwar Temple complex and the surrounding cave formations. Students were introduced to the evolution of Pateshwar's rock-cut architecture, sculpted shrines, and the craftsmanship embedded within the ancient temple precinct. Participants observed characteristic elements of traditional wada architecture such as central courtyards, carved wooden columns, timber joinery, and Mangalore-tiled roofs. Students actively documented architectural features through sketching, photography, and quick measure studies, focusing on façades, spatial hierarchy, balconies, and thresholds. The group then visited the Ram Mandir restoration site, where ongoing conservation using lime mortar and traditional repair methods offered insight into real-time restoration challenges. A subsequent visit to the historic Jabreshwar Mandir allowed the team to understand the cultural significance and living heritage associated with the precinct.

The visit further included interactions with local stakeholders, caretakers, and heritage professionals, deepening students' awareness of conservation practices and community involvement. Guidance from the Naik-Nimbalkar family, local historian Dr. Sagar Nikam, and Shri Baba Suryawanshi added immense value by providing historical context and facilitating site access. The field-based learning experience strengthened students' skills in documentation, visual analysis, and architectural interpretation. Overall, the Phaltan Heritage Study Visit proved to be an enriching and inspiring activity, reinforcing the importance of heritage awareness, conservation sensitivity, and continued engagement with historic environments beyond World Heritage Week.

WORLD HERITAGE WEEK 2025-26 – MENAVALI GHAT HERITAGE WALK, WAI – (DAY 5)

On 23rd November 2025, as part of World Heritage Week 2025-26, students of YSPM's Yashoda College of Architecture participated in the Menawali Ghat Heritage Walk (Day 07) at Menawali Ghat and Menawali Wada, Wai. The event was coordinated by Ar. Atharva Pore and Ar. Shahruraj Salunkhe under the academic schedule for the year 2025-26.

The heritage walk was conducted by Ar. The walk through the wada precinct and temple surroundings enabled students to examine the region's built environment closely and understand its relationship with the natural riverside setting. Students actively engaged in sketching, heritage photography, and on-site documentation, recording sculptural details, spatial organization, and architectural features. The event was enriched by academic collaboration with INTACH and BNCA CCS, Pune, which added depth to the learning experience. Throughout the walk, students discussed traditional construction techniques, conservation concerns, and the cultural identity embedded in the heritage structures.

The Menawali Ghat Heritage Walk significantly enhanced students' experiential learning by strengthening their ability to analyze heritage sites on-ground, interpret historical narratives, and understand the importance of cultural landscapes in architectural education. The event aligned with the broader objectives of World Heritage Week—promoting interaction with local heritage and encouraging future architects to value and conserve India's architectural legacy.
