INDUSTRIAL VISIT AT NULIFE PHARMACEUTICALS, PUNE

A part of curriculum, it is necessary to provide information about industry and to fulfill that, an industrial visit was organized at SG NuLife Pharmaceuticals, Pune. by Training and Placement cell on 24h Jan. 2024 at YSPM's, YTC, Faculty of Pharmacy. The visit started from college at 7.00 a.m., about 30 students of first year Diploma Pharmacy along with teaching staff was gathered in college and by bus and started journey towards Pune. We reached at Pune at 11.00 a.m. After reaching to the plant Mr. Prashant Saste, Production Manager greeted us. After that an introductory session was conducted by quality control (QC) department supervisor Mr. Akshay Walake. After giving information regarding QA and QC department students moved towards actual visit to plant. Ms. Aishwarya Ichake, Production Supervisor Liquid Oral dosage form gave information to students regarding various departments in production. She gave information about the products that were manufactured in unit. Products like tablet, capsule, creams, ointments and ear drops were produced in that unit. She then started to show various departments and there standard operating procedures. In tablet manufacturing students saw working of double cone blender, 32 station tablet punching machine and packing machine. For capsule production department students saw automated soft gelatin capsule filling machine. Next students saw bottle filling machine and labeling machine. After that students went to see storage unit for active pharmaceutical ingredient (API) and inactive pharmaceutical ingredient. Lastly students were visited QA and QC department and gain knowledge about documentation process and BMR of that department. After visiting all departments students asked their queries to Ms. Ms. Aishwarya Ichake and she gave answers to their queries. Visit concluded with gain of knowledge of students regarding various dosage forms and standard operating procedure (SOP) that are strictly followed in industry.

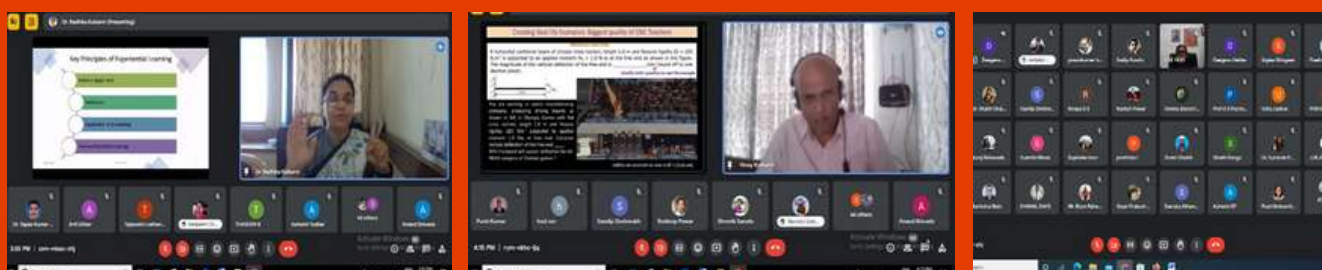

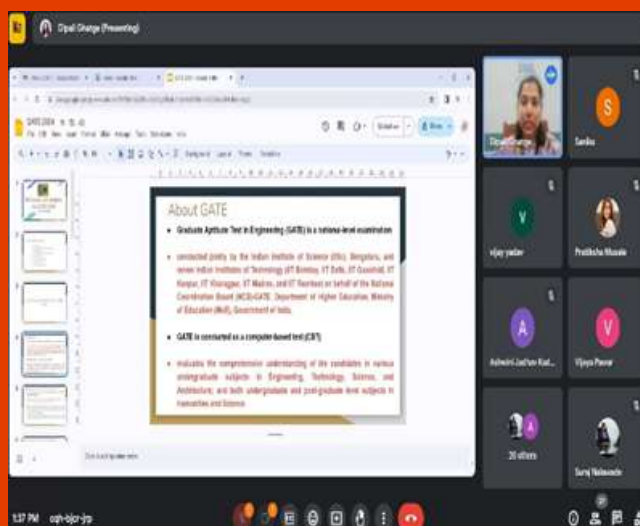

In the seventh edition of Pariksha Pe Charcha, Prime Minister Narendra Modi interacted with students, teachers and parents at New Delhi's Bharat Mandapam today. Over 4,000 students attended the event, officials say. More than 205.62 million students, along with over 14.93 million teachers and 5.69 million parents, have enrolled for PPC 2024. The proceedings were being streamed on various social media platforms, including the Education Ministry, the Prime Minister's Office, PIB, and others.

Talking to students, PM Modi explained that the stress is of three types – induced by parents, peers and self-induced as well. He said that students should compete with themselves and not worry about anyone else in the exam hall. Calling the students as the architects of future of India, PM Modi said the Pariksha Pe Charcha programme is like a pariksha for him too. He further suggested that all the teachers should treat all students equally and appreciate their skills during the teaching and learning process. Jitna kheloge, utna khiloge – The more you play, the more you will improve, says PM Modi at the event. Prioritising physical health is crucial for mental well-being, so students should aim to study in a well-lit areas with natural sunlight whenever possible. He also said that students should avoid confusion in choosing their stream. Body Language: Posture, gestures, and facial expressions convey confidence and professionalism, Active Listening: Demonstrate attentive listening skills by paraphrasing, asking questions, and providing feedback, Emotional Intelligence: Ability to manage emotions and empathize with others, Positive Attitude: Maintain a positive demeanour even in challenging situations. Alongside, developing a strong personality adds depth to one's professional profile.
