Third project is E waste Management system where students developed website for E waste Management system.

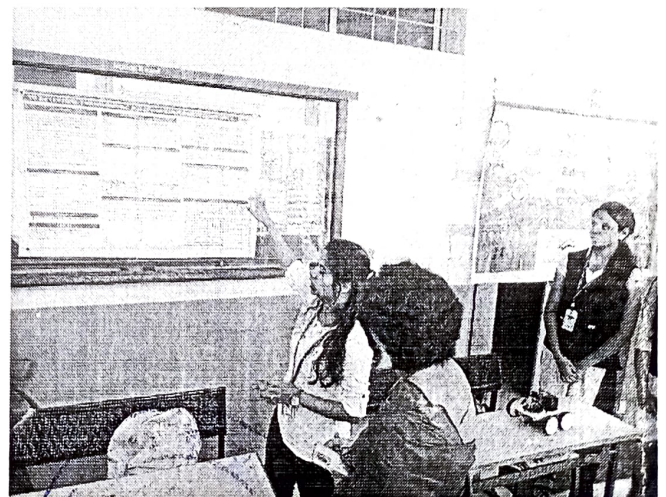
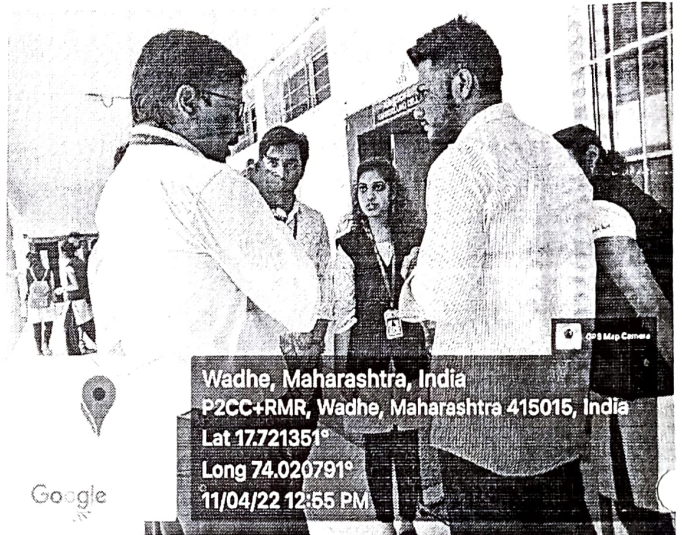
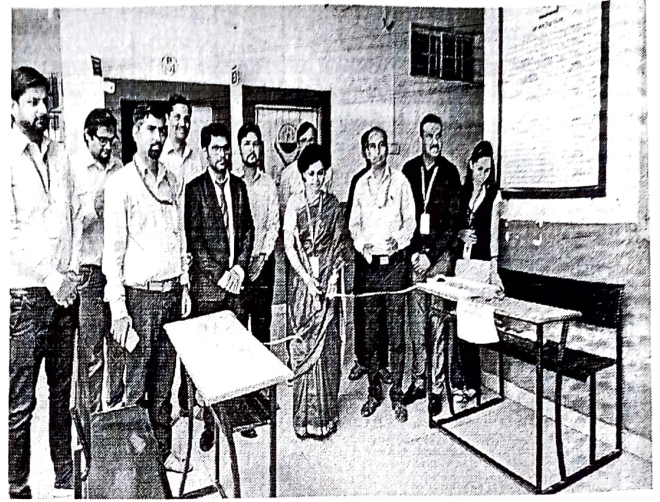
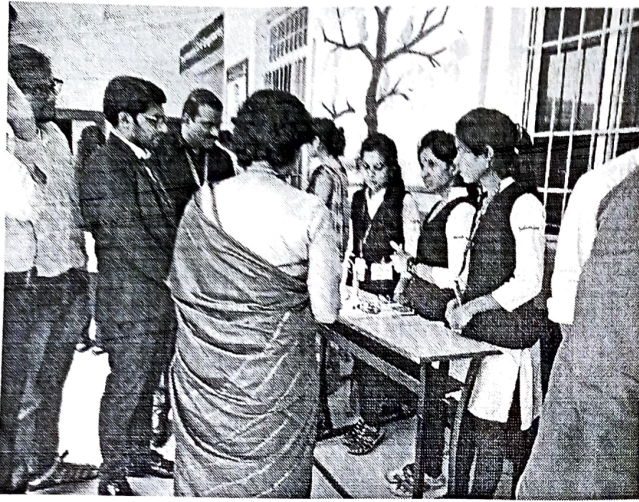
Fourth project is Simple Air; First Year Student developed such a device which can be used to fill air in the tube by using exhaust carbon in case of emergency.

## Yoga Day Celebration

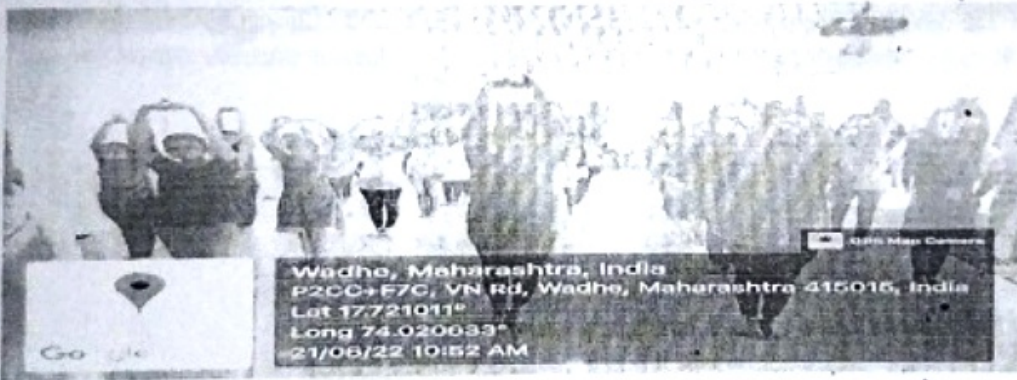
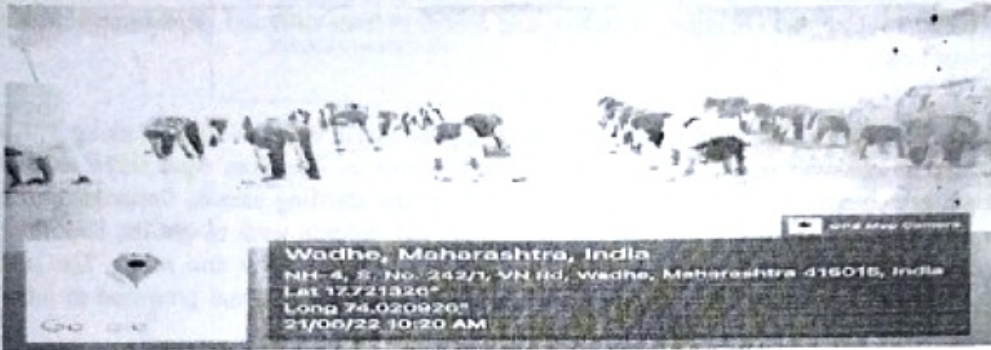

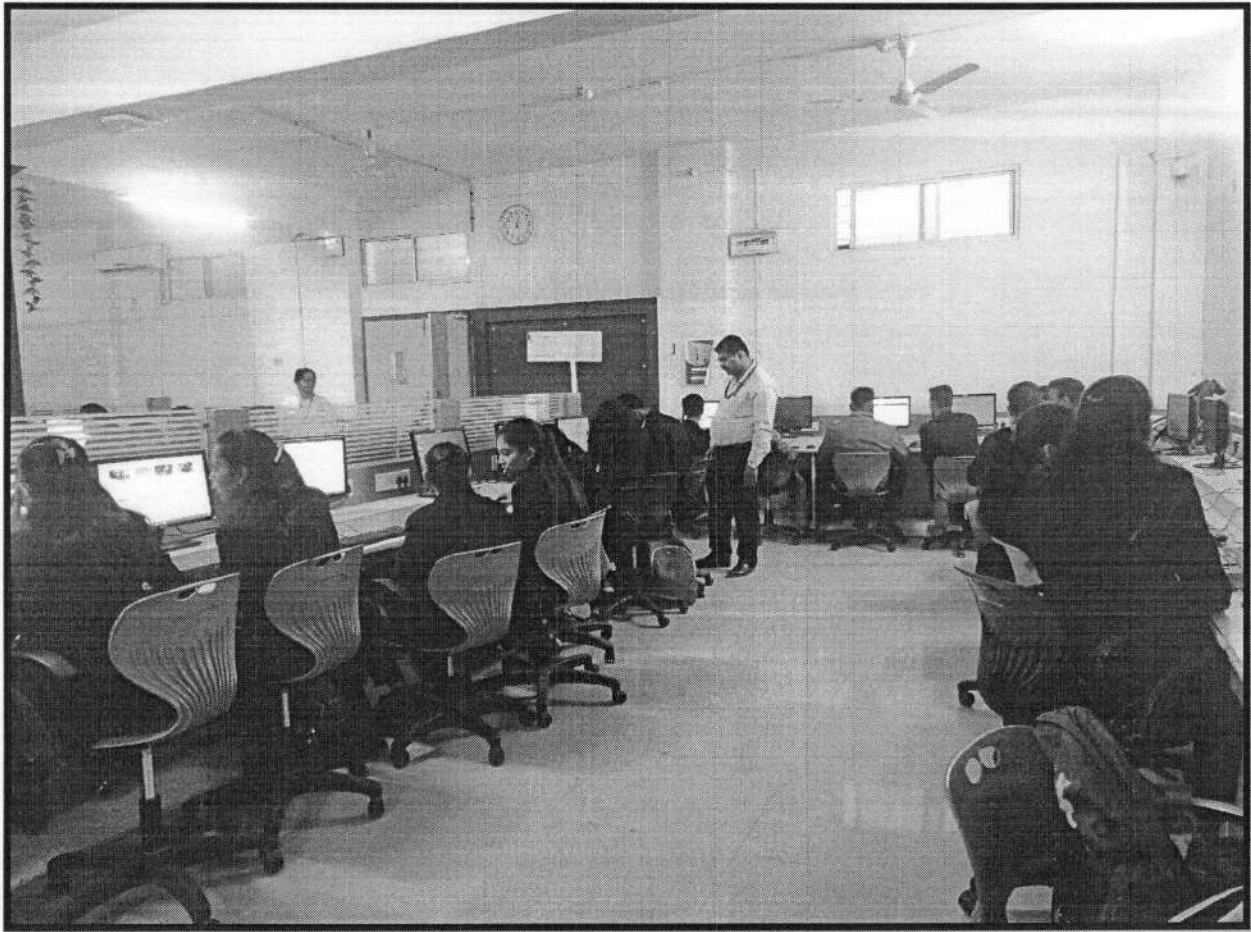
#### **In Brief:**

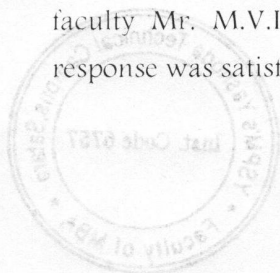
**Report of One Day Online workshop on "Business Analytics Using R"**

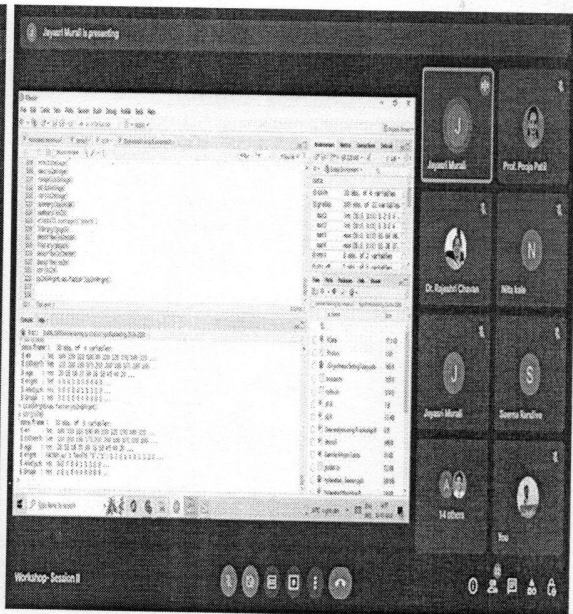
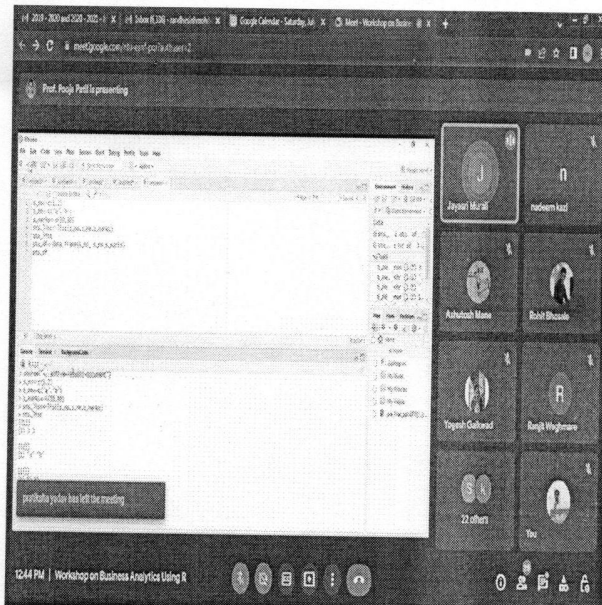
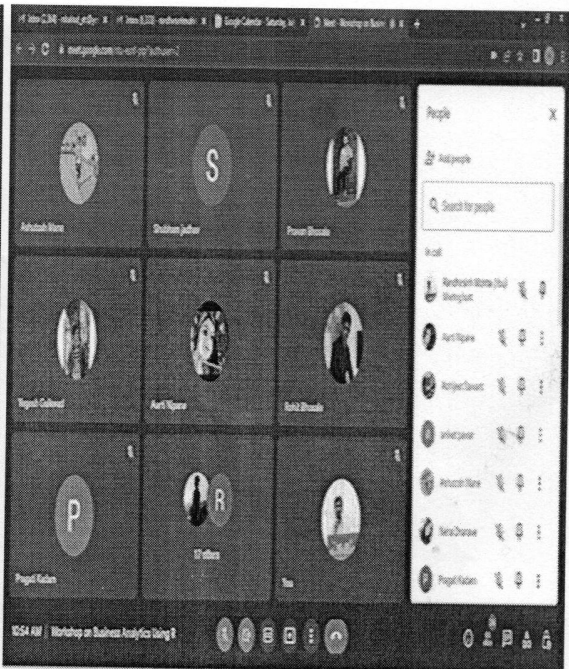
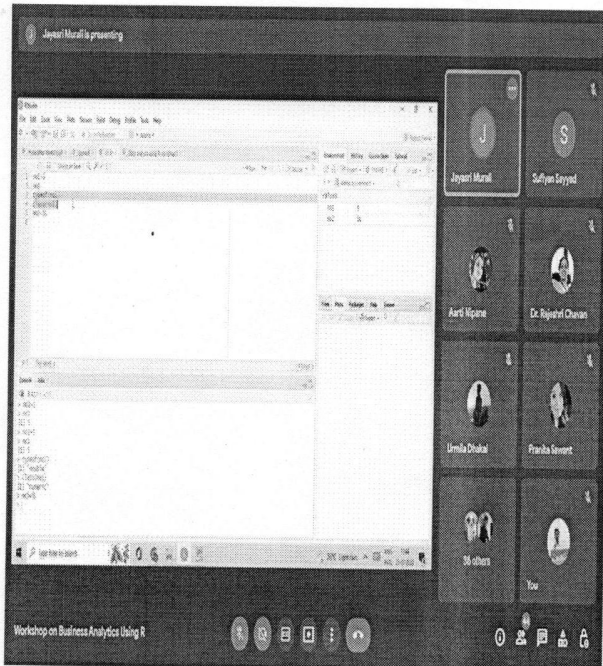
