
## **Report on Teacher's Day Celebration**

YSPMs Yashoda Technical Campus, Faculty of Pharmacy, Satara has arranged Hospital visit the “**ONCO life Cancer center, Satara**” on the 04<sup>th</sup> November 2023 for Diploma in Pharmacy students. For this hospital visit, around the 40 students and 3 staff gathered at the college campus. They reached at the hospital around 11.00 am. Hospital members welcomed to our staff and students. All the students are grouped into two groups. With each group one hospital staff and one college staff are allotted for maintaining proper discipline in hospital.

The visit to cancer hospital is selected because Cancer is the second leading cause of death in the United States, with more than 1.6 million new cases and nearly 600000 cancer-related deaths estimated to occur in recent research. The main purpose of hospital visit is to spread awareness regarding cancer.

Cancer is potentially curable if diagnosed and treated in early stages. Even in late stages where cure may not be possible patient can be treated to have meaningful life with disease. Correct diagnosis and management is of paramount importance. Kothari Medical Center, Satara has brought together the expertise within the hospital to provide comprehensive and coordinated care for patients with all types of cancers, including solid tumors and blood related diseases.

1. The Department offers broad scope of cancer services, ranging from education, screening and diagnosis, to treatment, pain management and palliative care.
2. Each patient at the hospital is treated by a team of highly skilled and adequately trained doctors, nurses and paramedical staff.

**Field visit**  
**At**  
**Water Treatment Plant**

YSPM, YTC'S, Department of Diploma in Pharmacy organized a field visit as a part of curriculum in Social Pharmacy subject to "Water Treatment Plant" which was located at Deputy Engineer Office, MIDC, Satara on 29<sup>th</sup> December 2023 for the F. Y. D. Pharm students. Around 50 first year students joined the visit under the guidance of faculty Mrs. P.A.Kadam and Ms. N.M.Bagwan.

Objectives:-

1. To understand the importance of safe water supply to the community.
2. To describe the process of water treatment.
3. Recognize the need to conserve and protect our environment and water sources.

Visit was started by 11 am and assisted by two staff members of Deputy Engineer Office namely, Mr. Vinayak Kadam and Ms. Bandal. They explained that Water treatment is a process whereby the used water or raw water from the river is treated in process to make the water more acceptable for a desired end-used. The goal of water treatment is to remove existing contaminants in the water, or reduce the concentration of such contaminants so the water becomes fit for its desired end-used.

Firstly they showed us collection chamber where raw water was collected from Krishna River. The raw water is first treated with chemical coagulant alum. The dose of alum varies depending upon the turbidity, color, temperature & pH of the water. In the rainy season they also used Bentonite for masking the colour of water. After that they showed us Clariflocculator, a machine which causes a slow and gentle stirring of the treated water in a flocculation chamber. The mechanized type of rotor is used. This causes the formation of thick copious white flocculent precipitate which was called as slug. This slug was then separate out from water by slug chambers. Then we moved towards the sedimentation tank and filtration unit where sand filters were used for further purification of water. The thickness of sand bed is 110 cm. After that they showed us chlorination unit where a chlorine gas is used for effective disinfection. This is the last step before storage and distribution of this purified water. Then we have visited the reservoir

where the purified water was stored and from there it was supplied to various areas of MIDC and Satara city.

From this visit, student gets the information and practical knowledge about the treatment of raw water and components used in treatment plant. Also it gave us the knowledge about the purification of water on large scale and made us aware about the quality of water since it may affect the human health especially. Also the trip made us realized that it is not easy to supply the water directly from the main supply to the people. The visit was nicely completed with group photography at 12:00pm.


